### Rabbi's Message



Dear Temple Oseh Shalom families and friends,

It must be hard for you to believe, as it is for me, that we are only six or seven weeks (it depends when you read this) from Rosh Hashanah. Believe me, Ruth, Mitch, and the Ritual Committee, Dennis, Ken and the Choir, Terrie, Tina, Rhoda, the Sisterhood and Brotherhood, and the TOS Board know this. They are all hard at work making plans, rehearsing, identifying participants, and volunteers for the apples and honey, Break-Fast, and every sacred and special moment of our High Holy Day season. And we thank them all.

We all look forward to the beautiful Shabbat Service on August 18th led by the officers and members of the Sisterhood and Brotherhood, a tradition for Temple Oseh Shalom during the summer for many years. Working with Ken, Dennis, and the choir, the inspiring liturgy and beautiful music will lift our souls.

But that means I will not see you until Rosh Hashanah, so here is my chance to offer some thoughts, guidance, and maybe end-of summer "homework assignments" before the new year! I bet all of us can remember getting ready for Rosh Hashanah as we grew up. For those of us who lived in cold climates, it

meant that it was time to bring out the heavy coats, the wool suits and dress shoes, the ironed tallit and white yarmulke for the High Holy Days. I remember the conversation in our house in Chicago, which is now quite socially unacceptable, when my mother would exclaim, "Now it is time for the mink coat," except she didn't have one. I often wondered if she wanted me to grab one when I got her coat from the coat closet at Synagogue! Of course, now, with our friends at PETA, wearing such a fur coat would be frowned upon! And down here, it is too hot!

But the autumn clothing, the heavy coats, finding the High Holy Day prayer books from your overladen book shelves (where DID we put our Machzors?!?) is only representative of the new year and its rituals. The most obvious change was all those people who would come to services that we had not seen the entire year, since last High Holy days, and even more, meeting new members of our community who are visiting—tasting—our services to see if they can find a new and meaningful spiritual home.

A couple of weeks ago, I read some beautiful words given by the now retiring president of Harvard, Dr. Lawrence Bacow, a son of Holocaust survivors and distinguished professor of Economics. Dr. Bacow had been Chancellor of MIT, and President of Tufts University before coming to Cambridge. It was his challenge to the graduates of the College, Graduate and Professional schools, and I think, to us, as we prepare for this sacred season.

Bacow wrote, "I want to challenge you—to save a seat for others, to make room for others, to ensure that the opportunities afforded you do not enrich your life alone. Whatever you do with your Harvard education, please be known at least as much for your humility, kindness, and concern for others, as for your professional accomplishments. Please work to extend opportunity to others just as it has been extended to you. That is how you will sustain the pride and joy you feel today. And that is the truth."

So, I ask you, think of those in the Sun City and Bluffton community who you could invite to our services, to save a seat for them. Invite them to become part of this congregation and one of your many friends. Let them know that the seats you save are not just to sit and read along or

listen to Ken and the choir. These seats are invitations to participate, to join the choir or the congregation's many committees and auxiliaries. That is what "saving a seat" means—to be next to you, to share your friendship and welcome, to teach others what Temple Oseh Shalom means to you. In this upcoming new year, may each of us extend to others the opportunities that have been extended to us.

Even though a person might have a good social network, they still might need our services but don't want to ask, so please let us know.

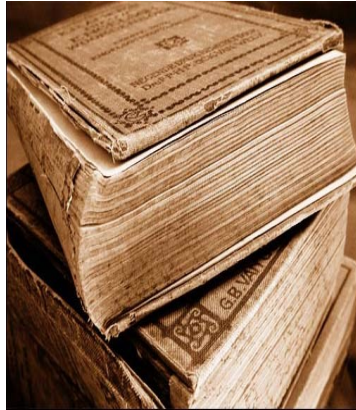
We also provide the Mi Shebeirach list read at services .
