### Rabbi's Message



Dear Temple Oseh Shalom family and friends,

I am pretty sure that most of you play those many word or number games, Sudoku, NY Times word games or many other options. We probably think that these are new and creative games, built on other games like Scrabble or Boggle. But it may surprise you to know that these word and number games were invented a thousand years ago in the time of the medieval mystics of the Kabbalah when our long ago rabbis interpreted the Hebrew alphabet! Unlike other written languages, our Hebrew letters were also our Hebrew numbers! The Alef, the first letter, had a numerical value of "1." Bet, the second letter had the value of "2," and so on. When the founders of the Hebrew alphabet reached the numerical value of "10," they used the tenth letter, the letter Yud. But when they needed "11," instead of the eleventh letter of the alphabet, Kof, they used the 10th letter and the first letter. Hebrew has 22 letters and the Gematria System was that the first ten letters of the alphabet were given the numerical value of 1-20, then the next eight letters are 20-90, and the final ones are 100, 200, 300, and 400.

This may be confusing, but it had an even more complicated aspect! When you were writing words with these letters, the letters had a numerical value! So, for example, using English

letters, the word “dog” would have the numerical value of d (4) + o (6) + g (3) =13! Our rabbis decided that words that added up to the same value would have a meaningful relationship. This alphabetical-numerical system is called Gematria and was used by the mystics and scholars as a way to interpret the deeper meaning of a Biblical text or Holy Book by interpreting the words with their numerical values compared to other words of the same value.

You may wonder, why am I using my Shofar article to talk about this? Many of you were at services in June when we not only celebrated Shavuot and the giving of the Ten Commandments, but we also commemorated the 17th anniversary of the very first TOS Shabbat Service, a service that took place exactly on June 16th, but in 2006. We were blessed that several people who were at services in June had also been at that service seventeen years ago! That means that we are now in the eighteenth year of Temple Oseh Shalom services! The Hebrew number of eighteen is eight (Chet) and ten (yud), which, when put together, spells the Hebrew word Chai, which we know means “Life.”

It is my hope that in this 18th year, we will all have a profound, meaningful, fulfilling “life,” and that we will give of our time, our talents, and our treasure to enhance the life of our beloved congregation and community!

Even though a person might have a good social network, they still might need our services but don't want to ask, so please let us know.

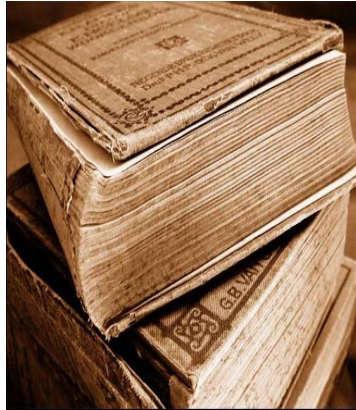

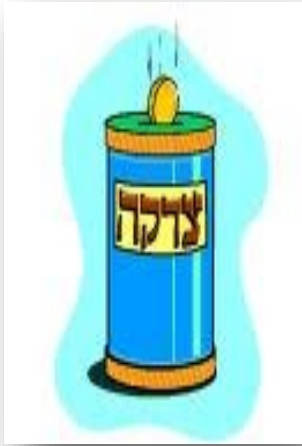
