### Rabbi's Message



Dear Friends and Family of Temple Oseh Shalom,

Over these many years, I have learned so much about our TOS family; your interests, your families near and far, your friends from here and “back home,” your dedication to golf or pickleball, mah jong or canasta, your love of travel or your back yard, your devotion to the Oseh Shalom and Bluffton communities, the diversity of synagogue and life experiences “back home” which all of you bring to the TOS congregational community. Even though a person might have a good social network, they still might need our services but don't want to ask, so please let us know.

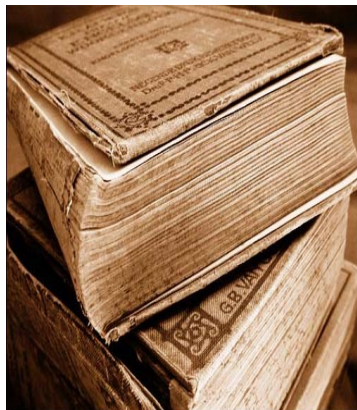
