Rabbi's Message



Dear Friends and Family of Temple Oseh Shalom, I don't know, but my guess is that our Shabbat/Yom Hashoah service two weeks ago was one of the most moving, poignant, and touching worship experiences you have had in a very long time. Ruth and her committee, Dennis and the wonderful Temple Oseh Shalom choir, our remarkable soloists, Cantor Ken Rosenberg, Michael Riegel and musicians, Dennis Smith and Jerry Anderson, and of course the reading of the names of loved ones from our Temple Oseh Shalom family moved me to tears—not to mention the depth of emotion created by “Somewhere Over the Rainbow” played so beautifully by Arline Rosen and Terri Weintraub, while we were remembering our lost or surviving families. It was magnificent, and I can't thank all the readers, (Sheila Mulligan, Deena Chontow, Susan Lisman, Tina Laboe, Bill Altman, Ralph Goldberg, Susan Zlotlow, Wilma Mazo, Al Richter, Judy Miller, Carol Liff, Floss Kaffee, Bernice Marshall, Terri Weintraub, Barry Zweiban, and Ruth Moroknek, enough for the somber yet inspiring service they gave us all.

It is typical for our Jewish tradition and worship that soon after we commemorate the profound sadness of the loss of so many of our people, we come together again, a few days later, first to remember Israel's heroes and soldiers who lost their lives in their fight for Israeli independence, and then immediately afterward, to celebrate Israel's independence. Before

all the dancing and flag waving symbolizing that remarkable, almost miraculous day in May 1948, when Jews stood tall before the world at the end of the United Nations control of the government in Palestine, with the stroke of a pen a proud group of individuals gathered together, and signed their names to an ornate illuminated manuscript, Israel's Declaration of Independence. In so many ways, I wish the unity of that moment, when 37 Orthodox and secular, Sephardic and Ashkenazi, rabbis and atheists, Middle eastern and Middle European, city dwellers and kibbitznikim, socialist and monarchist, prepared to sign this sacred and historic, aspirational and inspirational document.

I hope that you will join us on Friday, May 19th, at our Yom Haatzmaut-Israel Independence Shabbat Service, filled with special songs, readings, poetry, stories of heroism and courage, all illustrating that miraculous and unexpected day, when these disparate yet united people from every corner of the Jewish world gathered in a small room in Tel Aviv, under the guidance of David Ben Gurion, soon to be Israel's first Prime Minister.

Then, I encourage you to come join us for Torah study on Shabbat morning when we talk about what is going on in Israel today, the complexities of the political system in this beloved state. I know that the conversation will be respectful yet forceful and I hope you will be there to learn, listen, and contribute to the conversation. With every good wish for this momentous occasion, and with gratitude for the state that means so much to us all.

Even though a person might have a good social network, they still might need our services but don't want to ask, so please let us know.

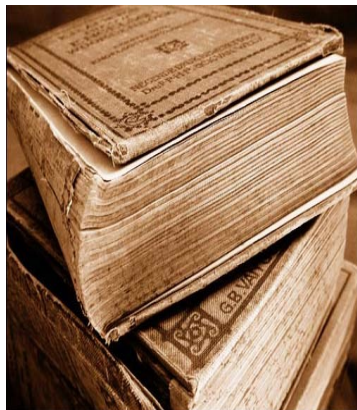
