Dear TOS family,

As hard as it is to believe, the High Holy Days will soon be here. I hope you're all well. The Ritual Committee is working on assigning all the honors. Dennis Smith and the choir have been rehearsing, and the Social Committee, chaired by Cindi Walton and David Glazer, is working on the Yom Kippur Break the Fast. Mark your calendars for September 25th! It will be held at 6:15 PM this year. Watch your emails for more information.

The High Holy Day schedule will soon be posted as well. Erev Rosh Hashanah begins on Friday, September 15, and Yom Kippur begins on Sunday, September 24 evening with Kol Nidre. The evening services are at 7:30 PM and the morning services are at 10 AM.

On Yom Kippur, we will also hold our annual food drive. This year we will be supporting the Bluffton Soup Kitchen. You've already gotten a list of foods they need. We know you'll support this food drive as you're always so generous. We will distribute bags on Rosh Hashanah for anyone who needs one. Food Lion will be donating those bags. The food will be collected on Yom Kippur.

We are also doing something special this year. On Thursday, September 14, at 1:30 PM, we will open the Genizah (burial site) at our cemetery to bury the Torah we have that is moldy, as well as any old prayer books, yarmulkes, talleisim, and any other religious articles you would like to dispose of. Rabbi Kanter will join us for this event and there will be a short service because we are burying a Torah. Watch your emails for notification about this.

We have gotten responses about the Bereavement Committee we wish to form for our congregants who need it. Stay tuned for more information. Thank you to those who stepped up to help.

As you know, we support a couple of programs as part of our Temple Outreach. They are Family Promise as well as Pack Buddies, both of which we have been doing for many years now. Back Pack Buddies is a program that sends home with food for weekends for children who are in need. It's an extremely worthwhile project and provides great support to those the needy. I want to thank Leanne and Steven Swallowood for their coordination of Back

Pack Buddies. Family Promise takes in homeless families for several months. They teach life skills to the parents, help them find work and housing, while providing food and shelter. We provide meals to the families every few months. Steve Dutka is chair of Outreach and he may reach out to get help with meals when needed.

Even though a person might have a good social network, they still might need our services but don't want to ask, so please let us know.

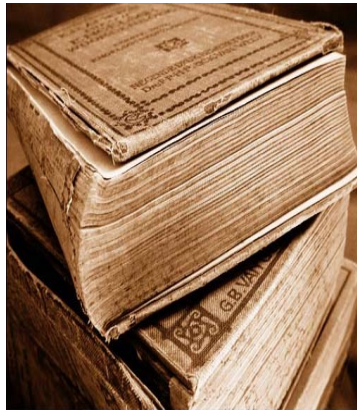
